### MADRID

- **Santiago Bernabeu Stadium** - Take an exclusive tour of the locker rooms, tunnel, trophy room, and interactive museum.
- **Legends Football Museum** - Supported by FIFA and major football associations, the new football museum spans over 45000 square feet and 7 floors.
- **Plaza Mayor** - Madrid's most recognizable square, known for its vibrant atmosphere.
- **Retiro Park** - A vast, verdant park with beautiful sculptures, a lake, and the Crystal Palace.
- **Del Prado Museum** - One of the most important and renowned art museums globally, housing an exquisite collection of European art.
- **Royal Palace** - Visit the official residence of the Spanish Royal Family, primarily used for ceremonial events.



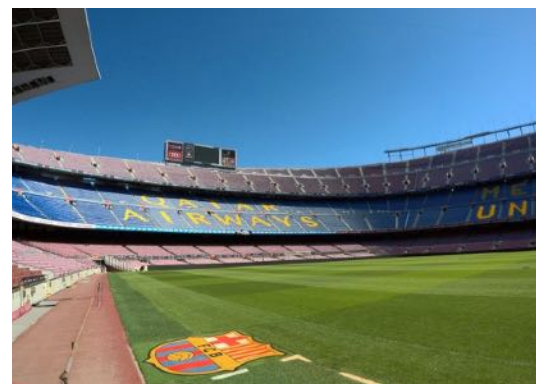
### AROUND MADRID

- **Segovia** - Spain's monument-filled city boasts the Roman Aqueduct, fairytale castle Alcázar, and 16th-century Cathedral.
- **Toledo** - Once the capital of Spain, the City is known for its blend of Christian, Jewish, and Muslim influences.



### BARCELONA

- **Camp Nou** - Explore the storied arena resonating with the glorious victories of FC Barcelona.
- **La Rambla** - Stroll down the most famous street in Barcelona and stop at the famous Boqueria market.
- **Gothic Quarter** - Stroll through the charming narrow medieval streets and take in the 13th-century cathedral.
- **Sagrada Familia** - Visit of Gaudi's Roman Catholic Church and its crypt. Climb the towers for a view on Barcelona!



- **Park Guell** - Another masterpiece by Gaudí, this park is filled with colorful ceramic tiles and architectural elements.

## AROUND BARCELONA

- **Montserrat** - Visit the 1000-year-old Monastery of Santa Maria de Montserrat, perched in the spire-shaped mountains of Montserrat.
- **Girona** - See the city's imposing Cathedral and explore the narrow streets of the Old Jewish Quarter.
- **Calella de Palafrugell** This charming fishing village represents the essence of Mediterranean beauty with its white-washed houses and beautiful seaside views.
- **Tossa de Mar** - Visit the charming Old Town of the coastal walled city and enjoy the crystal-clear waters of the Mediterranean Sea.
- **Figueres** - The birthplace of Salvador Dalí and home to the Dalí Theatre-Museum, which showcases many of his works.
- **Besalu** - A small town with a well-preserved medieval bridge and old town, making it feel like a journey back in time.
- **Collioure** - Cross the border into Collioure, which inspired painter Henri Matisse and is considered the birthplace of Fauvism.
