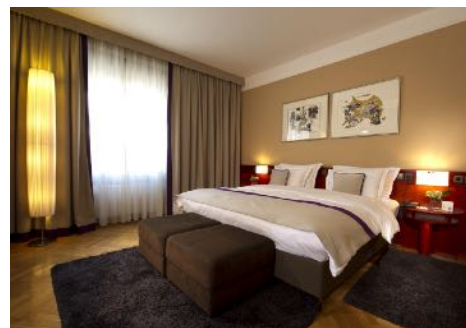

Ljubljana, which is the capital of Slovenia, is situated five hours away from Munich by car and one hour and thirty minutes away from Umag, Croatia. The four-star Hotel Slon is located on a pedestrian street in the Old Town of Ljubljana, just a few steps away from Prešeren Square.

The Crowne Plaza Hotel is situated in Quarto d'Altino, a small town just a 20-minute drive from Venice and 15 minutes from the airport. The Quarto d'Altino train station, located just 500 yards from the hotel, has regular trains that depart every 30 minutes and can take you to the heart of Venice in less than an hour.



Suggested Cultural excursions

MUNICH

- Start the visit with Marienplatz, the central square in Munich's heart, and see the monumental 260-foot-tall New Town Hall. See the show given by the building's Glockenspiel or chime at 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 05:00 p.m.
- Visit the Church of Our Lady, the landmark of Munich, and climb the Tower for a great view of Munich and the Bavarian Alps.
- Stroll down the compact Historic center to Odeonplatz, leading to Ludwigstrasse, Munich's most monumental boulevard.
- Visit the 400-year-old Royal Brewery to taste German beer and see traditional German music performers.
- Visit the Allianz Arena, home to FC Bayern Munich and TSV 1860 Munich, and the Bayern Museum.
- Other places of interest: Nymphenburg Palace and the 1972 Olympic Games site of Olympiapark.



SALZBURG

- Visit Salzburger Dom, the city's cathedral and landmark.
- Funicular ride to the 900-year-old Hohensalzburg Fortress and Europe's most extensive fortification above the city.
- Visit the house of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, now a museum dedicated to the musician's life.
- Visit the Old Town of Salzburg, a site inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list, and St Peter's Abbey, dating back to 696.



LJUBLJANA, LAKE BLED & SOCA RIVER RAFTING - SLOVENIA

Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia, is a beautiful small city situated on the river Ljubljanica that flows between the Historical center and the castle hill above. Its river's banks are filled with restaurants and shops. The town boasts

one of the most relaxing atmospheres of all European capitals.

Visit Bled, one of Slovenia's most popular tourist resorts famous for its 11th-century castle overlooking the Lake and the small island, which a 15-minute rowboat ride can access.



KLAGENFURT & LAKE WORTHERSEE AREA, AUSTRIA

Klagenfurt is the capital of the southern region of Carinthia, with a history dating back to 1160. The town boasts an attractive Old Town quarter with medieval walls, picturesque streets, and Renaissance courtyards with trendy shops, galleries, and cafés.

Take in the incredible panorama at Wörthersee Lake. Known as “Austria's Riviera,” Carinthia's lake reaches temperatures around 28°C (82°F) and is notorious for its water quality. The lake is located 40 minutes from Ljubljana and 15 minutes from Klagenfurt.



VENICE - ITALY

- See St Mark's Square, Venice's principal square surrounded by incredible architecture, including St Mark's Basilica.
- See the famous Bridge of Sighs, which connected the old prison to the interrogation room.
- Visit the Correr Museum and discover the Art and History of Venice.
- Free time in Venice to wander around the city's endless mazes of backstreets and 150 canals.
